

Patient instruction for Early Morning Urine (EMU) Collection

- These samples are to test for a slow growing bacteria and three consecutive samples are needed.
- The first urine of the day needs to be taken in to the first pot. Label this specimen with you Forename, Surname, Date of Birth and the date and time of the sample. Store in a cool place
- Repeat this process on the next two days. This gives three consecutive samples.
- When all three samples are complete, take the specimens and request form to either your
 GP or the Pathology Laboratory at Frimley Park Hospital.
