

Patient instruction for Early Morning Urine (EMU) Collection

- These samples are to test for a slow growing bacteria and three consecutive samples are needed.
- The first urine of the day needs to be taken in to the first pot. Label this specimen with you Forename, Surname, Date of Birth and the **date and time** of the sample. Store in a cool place
- Repeat this process on the next two days. This gives three consecutive samples.
- When all three samples are complete, take the specimens and request form to either your GP or the Pathology Laboratory at Frimley Park Hospital.
